The next awards will be for Spring 2020 and Fall 2020. It is anticipated that \$70,000 (Canadian) per year will be awarded through distributions of small (\$4,000) to large (\$20,000) annual awards. Awards may be given for multiple years, but must be renewed each year. Applications for Spring 2020 must be received by January 15, 2020 to be considered. Note that applications can be made just 3 months prior to the first payment date, instead of 9 months prior to the first payment date, as was done in years past. Thus applications for Fall 2020 can be submitted by January 15, 2020 or July 15, 2020. Early applications will typically receive preference. Applications should be sent to the chairperson of the Advisory Board, Patricia Huscroft, at the email given below. We will only accept initial or renewal applications or payment requests sent by email. Please scan in any handwritten items and attach them. We must receive email documents as PDF files, with consolidation of all information into a single PDF file less than 5MB being the preferred method. If you send in official transcripts by normal mail, you must also include unofficial marks in the email that you send. We require email as it allows you to review the legibility of what you send, before you send it, and allows us to deal with applications regardless of where we are. If applicants do not receive an acknowledgement of receipt of their application within a week, they should investigate and contact Patricia Huscroft. The application forms are available on line at www.huscroft.ca where the application procedures are explained in detail.

The responsibility of making award recommendations is the role of the Advisory Board. The Advisory Board members are Patricia Huscroft, Peter Dempster, Taylor Compo and Samantha Dempster. If you have any questions, please contact one of the Advisory Board members. Their contact information will be available on line at www.huscroft.ca. Over the coming months I will look forward to receiving applications for Spring 2020 and Fall 2020 awards.
